

Required documents

1. A **research proposal** for a PhD dissertation, with specific references to the research topic, related concepts, and research plans (approx. 3,000 words)
2. An original official score report of **one** of the following English proficiency tests.
 - TU-GET: a minimum score of 550 or
 - IELTS: a minimum score of 6.5
 - TOEFL (internet-based): a minimum score of 80 or TOEFL (computer-based): a minimum score of 213 or TOEFL (paper-based): a minimum score of 550
3. A copy of Bachelor's degree and Master's degree certificates and official transcripts
4. A copy of identification card or passport
5. One 2-inch color photo
6. Any other important documents (e.g. name change document)

Note:

- An Applicant must submit the supporting documents No.1-6 on the written test date.
- A successful candidate is required to present all relevant official documents to complete the entry process.

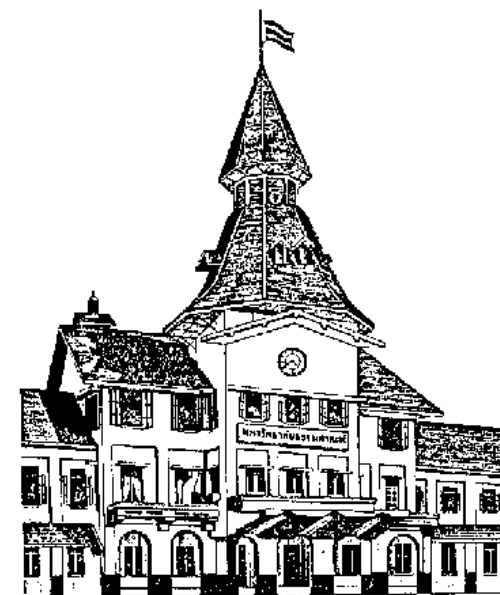

An applicant holds a Master's degree in any field of study from a local or foreign institution recognized by the Thammasat University Council with a minimum GPA of 3.25.

Selection criteria

- An applicant must achieve the minimum score of one of the following English proficiency tests.
 - **TU-GET**: a minimum score of **550** or
 - **IELTS**: a minimum score of **6.5** or
 - **TOEFL (internet-based)**: a minimum score of **80** or **TOEFL (computer-based)**: a minimum score of **213** or **TOEFL (paper-based)**: a minimum score of **550**
- An applicant passes the written test and interview.
- An applicant submits a Dissertation Proposal, with specific references to the research topic, related concepts, and research plans.

TU-GET

The TU-GET is a test of English language proficiency required for Thammasat University's undergraduate and graduate students.
